To All Authorized Inspectors (AI) and Designated Inspection Facilities (DIF)

Re: Change to CVIP Inspection Report (CVSE 0014) Form

In some cases, commercial vehicles may be equipped with components, tools, accessories or items that may not be specifically noted in the Vehicle Inspection Manual. While these items may not be specified, their location and/or function may require authorized inspectors (AI) to examine and assess the condition, attachment and security of the identified items to ensure the overall road safety of the vehicle.

Effective February 19, 2014, the Commercial Vehicle Inspection Program online inspection report form (CVSE 0014) has been revised to include a specific section to record and report "Other Vehicle Components".

Identified on the form as Section 11, AI's may indicate additional vehicle components that have been examined and assessed. Information and notes may be included in this section specifying the condition, attachments and security of the identified items. Where no other vehicle components are identified, the CVIP report for this section should be marked as non-applicable (N/A).
