## <u>Re: CVSE and ICBC Appointed Agents to discontinue issuing Special Case</u> <u>Motive Fuel User Permits</u>

Due to a regulatory change made by the Consumer Taxes Branch, Commercial Vehicle Safety & Enforcement (CVSE) and ICBC Appointed Agents no longer have the authority to issue Motive Fuel User Permits based on the volume of fuel carried in the supply tank of an IFTA commercial vehicle entering BC.

All future Motive Fuel User Permits will be issued and charged based on the number of kilometres travelled in BC. The table below lists the motor fuel tax rate and carbon tax rate used to calculate the deposit.
