NOTICE

To All Authorized Inspectors (AI) and Designated Inspection Facilities (DIF)

Re: Format Change to Certificate of Approval Decal


Effective immediately, the three small individual decal tabs indicating the decal number are no longer part of the approval decal format. As the handwritten multi-page inspection reports are not acceptable for use, the decal tabs are no longer required to legitimize the carbon copied pages.


The requirements for cutting decals to the required expiration date and application to the vehicle remains unchanged. On the inspection report, the correct decal number must be displayed in the "Place Decal Here" box; however, the decal tab inclusion is no longer necessary. Image displayed below.



The Vehicle Inspection Program will amend the PVIP and CVIP inspection forms as soon as practical.

- 4) CUT THE TWO NON-APPLICABLE YEARS FROM EACH DECAL.
- 5) STICK CUT OFF PORTIONS OF DECAL TO THE BACK OF FACILITY INSPECTION REPORT FILE COPY.
